**MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT CONCERNING FILING OF SECTION 274  
NOTICES BY HAMILTON CITY COUNCIL, SOUTH WAIKATO DISTRICT COUNCIL,  
OTOROHANGA DISTRICT COUNCIL AND CNI IWI LAND MANAGEMENT LIMITED**

**Introduction**

[1] On 20 October 2020, the Registry was notified by counsel for the Hamilton City Council, the South Waikato District Council and the Otorohanga District Council that their section 274 notices had not been uploaded on the Court's website and they were not included in the list of case parties as at 2 October 2020 that is also uploaded on the Court's website.

[2] The Court has been informed that unfortunately, due to technical reasons the Registry did not receive these notices via the dedicated email address set up for this purpose.

[3] On 28 October 2020, the Registry was notified that the section 274 notices filed by CNI Iwi Land Management Limited also had not been received.

[4] Having been provided with proof from counsel that the section 274 notices were sent to the correct email address, before the expiry date of 29 September 2020, and that



all the relevant parties were served with these section 274 notices, the Court is satisfied that an application to waive the time limits for filing these notices is not required.

**Directions**

[5] The Registry is directed to process and upload on the Court's website the section 274 notices filed by the Hamilton City Council, the South Waikato District Council, the Otorohanga District Council and CNI Iwi Land Management Limited.

[6] An updated list of case parties is also to be distributed to all current parties and uploaded on the Court's website.
