(2) Set out locality of dam and nature of proposed work as set forth in application, modified, however, so as to accord with the grant, adding such other particulars as are necessary, including plan of land, if surveyed, and purpose for which water is to be used.

On Dip Creek a tributary of Dead Bullock Creek On Grazing Run NO 600 Sutton Survey District. Dam consists of One and One eighth steel plate supported by four 40 lbs rails the whole set in a concrete base and let into concrete abutments at either side. Length of dam wall 10 ft 9 ins. Height four feet at back . 5ft 7 ins in front. Breadth of same at base 2 feet. Length and width of water area 100 feet long, average 6 ft 6 ins wide. Estimated time and cost of construction two weeks £25. Water supply for Military Camp.
