Topic(s): DR: DR: resource consents and notices of requirement for Otaki to north of Levin state highway project

I am a person who made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings.

I am not a trade competitor for the purposes of [section 308C](#) of the Resource Management Act 1991.

I am directly affected by an effect of the subject of the appeal that—

- (a) adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.

I am interested in all of the proceedings.

I am interested in the following particular issues as set out in the submission on the resource consent application, dated February 28th, 2023. I understand this submission has already been filed with the court by the applicant. Issues include:

- *The CIA presented by Ngati Raukawa and Assessment of Environmental Effects include inaccurate historical narratives about Muaūpoko, and other Kurahaupō iwi.*
- *Muaūpoko information and appropriate design responses are not included in the CEDF.*
- *Muaūpoko rangatiratanga, mana whakahaere and our relationship with ancestral lands and waters in our traditional rohe and area of interest is not adequately provided for or protected.*
- *There is concern surrounding how involvement, decision making and role development will be managed through both iwi's involvement.*

I conditionally oppose the relief sought because—

- Amendments are requested to better recognise and protect Muaūpoko relationship with ancestral lands and waters throughout the project and beyond.

I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
