- There is concern surrounding how involvement, decision making and role development will be managed through both iwi's involvement.

• Amendments are requested to better recognise and protect Muaūpoko relationship with ancestral lands and waters throughout the project and beyond.

I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
