MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT

(12 OCTOBER 2023)

[1] The Court conducted a pre-hearing conference at Levin on 09 October 2023. At the conference the Court worked through counsel's joint memorandum of 20 September 2023 which identified outstanding issues and a suggested timetable for the hearing and invited parties to comment further as to these matters.

[2] Paragraph 17 of the memorandum seeks directions in relation to parties identifying those witnesses whom they intend to cross-examine. I make those directions accordingly:



- a) All parties are to advise counsel for Waka Kotahi of all witnesses for all parties, that they wish to cross-examine by **4pm on Tuesday 17 October 2023**; and,
- b) Counsel for Waka Kotahi are to collate that information and advise the Court

by 4pm on Wednesday 18 October 2023.

[3] Witnesses not required for cross-examination and whom the Court does not intend to question will be excused from attending the hearing

[4] Discussions were had in relation to Waka Kotahi's proposed hearing timetable contained in appendix A of the memorandum of 20 September. The Court indicated that the hearing timetable as proposed is generally suitable, with a few exceptions, however refinement will be expected as further clarification of matters occurs in the coming days.

[5] Utilizing the information regarding cross-examination intentions and in collaboration with the Councils and the Court, I direct Waka Kotahi to file and circulate a final proposed hearing timetable by **4pm on Thursday 19 October 2023.**

[6] I also note that Waka Kotahi filed some of its rebuttal evidence outside of the directed timeframe. I grant a retrospective waiver in relation to this filing.
